Please be aware pupil attendance is being monitored once more after COVID. If your child is absent you must ring the absence line and inform us of their illness to ensure the correct code. Holidays during school time must be requested and will only be authorized if your child has attendance over 90%.

Breakfast Club – unfortunately the provision of breakfast club has been running at a loss for the last financial year. This is due to unpaid arrears on pupils accounts. The childcare element of the provision begins at 8am with staffing paid by the school. The free breakfast is provided by Welsh Government. A register of pupils is taken each day but we would kindly ask parents to pay for the service in order for us to keep providing this essential service for working parents. Parents are asked to pay £1.50 per day and half this amount for siblings.
