Further discussion points:

Actions:

1. All raffle prizes to be collected by the 30th June.
2. **Sam** to provide list of stalls/ businesses providing raffle prizes for pupils to create posters/ advertisement to be shared with parents/ printed and displayed. (to be sent by 30th June)
3. **Sam** to complete letter to be sent out on 23rd June requesting donations of old school uniform/ football boots and books for stall. To be brought to school on 30th June (no donations after this date).
4. **Sam** to complete information letter regarding fate to be sent to parents W.C. 23rd June
5. 30th June – non school uniform day for pupils – payment being a donation of large chocolate bars/ sweets/ non-alcoholic bottles (can split between year groups) ready for tombola stall.
6. **Sam** to contact supermarkets to request donations – community champions.
7. **Claire** – contact stall holders.
8. **Sharon/ Nadine** – request raffle prizes from local businesses using donation letter.
9. **Harriet** – request raffle prizes from wider businesses.
10. **Nadine** – contact the mens shed to see if they would like a stall.

Date of next meetings:
