

DIOCESE OF MENEVIA INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL

- 1. The name of the school is **St. Joseph's Catholic Primary School**.
- 2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
- 3. The language which is used as the medium of instruction and the normal business of the school is : **English**.
- 4. The name of the governing body is: **St. Joseph's Catholic Primary School Governing body.**
- 5. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) 1 parent governor
 - (b) 1 LA governor
 - (c) 1 teacher governor
 - (d) 1 staff governor
- (e) 7 foundation governors (must be 2 more than total of all the other governors).
- (f) The head teacher (except at any time when she has given written notice to the clerk to the governing body of the school that she chooses not to be a governor).
- 6. Total number of Governors.... 12.... (except at any time when the Headteacher has given notice as above that he/she chooses not to be a governor, when the total number of Governors will be ..11)
- 7. The school was founded by and is part of the Catholic Church. The school is to be conducted as a Catholic School in accordance with the canon law and teachings of the Roman Catholic Church, and in accordance with the Trust Deed of the Diocese of Menevia and in particular:
- (a) religious education is to be in accordance with the teachings, doctrines, discipline and general and particular norms of the Catholic Church;
- (b) religious worship is to be in accordance with the rites, practices, discipline and liturgical norms of the Catholic Church; and at all times the school

is to serve as a witness to the Catholic faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ.

- 8. Foundation governors are appointed and may be removed by the Bishop of Menevia (or any other person exercising Ordinary jurisdiction on his behalf).
- 8. If there is any excess in the number of foundation governors, the person named in paragraph 7 above shall remove sufficient foundation governors to ensure that such excess is eliminated.
- 9. Subject to regulations 33-37 of the Government of Maintained Schools (Wales) Regulations 2005, this instrument of government comes into effect on the date of making.
- 10. This instrument was made by order of the City and County of Swansea Local Education Authority on November 4th 2020.
