Both Rainbows and SunBeams explore the following themes:—

- Anger and hurt coping skills
- Facing fears and worries coping skills

- Belonging to my family
- Different kinds of family
- Endings and beginnings change
- Weathering the storm adapting, adjusting
- Living with change
- Celebrate me session a celebration and conclusion of the programme; going forward.
