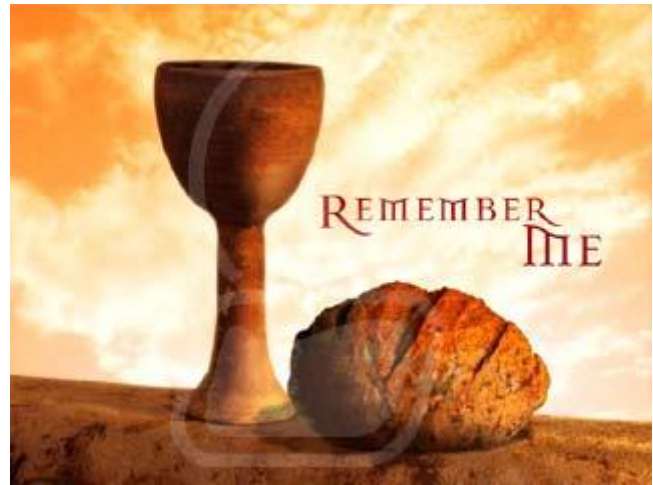
Act of Sorrow

Thank you for coming to me.

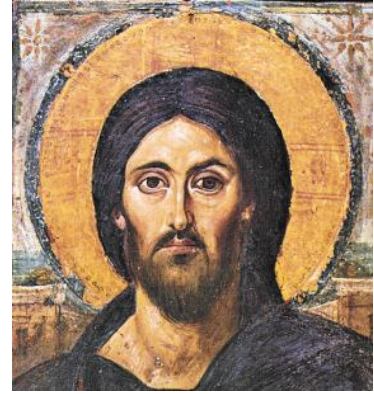


Confiteor
